



## Animal Welfare Statement

At Legian Beach Hotel, we do not own any animals or operate any farms. We do have wild lives around the premises and they all live undisturbed by our activities.

Our approach to wild lives is widely referring to internationally accepted 'Five Freedoms' of animals as follows:

1. **Freedom from Hunger and Thirst**, by providing daily feeding to the wild lives and make fresh water available in many places
2. **Freedom from Discomfort**, by maintaining our large garden with big trees for their natural habitants. We will not disturb or destroy their environment or nest or breeding grounds.
3. **Freedom from Pain, Injury or Disease**, by being cautioned with our day to day operations especially when it comes to hazardous materials or chemical used by the hotel.
4. **Freedom to Express Normal Behaviour**, by providing sufficient space and not disturbing their habitants.
5. **Freedom from Fear and Distress**, by ensuring our natural conditions and maintain good quality of fresh water around the premises

As a Hotel, we source dairy, and a range of animal proteins for our guests consumption across our business and we share the concerns of our stakeholders regarding the welfare of animals raised for food.

### SCOPE

We aim to ensure good welfare conditions for all farm animals impacted by our business and the commitments laid out below apply to all animal derived ingredients used for our guest consumptions.

To increase our effectiveness, we will focus on priority areas for our business and those categories where we can have the greatest impact. These priority categories have been identified as dairy, poultry, pork and beef.

As a Hotel, we source animal proteins from a range of trusted partners that deliver reliable quality and safe ingredients and to promote good practice. We recognize that the perception of good practice can be influenced by many factors, including cultural and religious beliefs. To help implement clearly defined and measurable actions, we acknowledge our stakeholders concerns on the use of animals for testing. Legian Beach Hotel does not carry out testing of its products and services on animals and we will also not support the sales of fashion materials made out of animal products such as skin, tooth, nail, etc.



**OUR COMMITMENT**






